GRASSLAND WEED CONTROL UPDATE



The new clover safe dock herbicide from Corteva **ProClova XL** (Rinskor + Amidosulfuron) was duly registered just before Christmas and brings a valuable new tool for grassland dock control where clover is a valuable part of the sward. The caveats are that the overnight temperatures need to be above 8°C for 3 days before and after the proposed application date and there is a 12m aquatic buffer zone with the requirement for Drift Reduction Technology (DRT) to be used when spraying. **ProGrass** (Fluroxypyr + Triclopyr + Arylex) Corteva's other new product also has the same aquatic buffer and requirement for DRT.

Clopyralid as in **Thistlex** (Clopyralid + Triclopyr) and **Aminopyralid** as in **Forefront** (Aminopyralid + Triclopyr) are not allowed to be applied to cutting grass and it is very important if thistles are a problem, alternative chemistry such as **Thrust** (2-4D + Dicamba) + **Gal-Gone** (Fluroxypyr) is used at least 21 days prior to harvest to allow sufficient die back of the weeds so they are not included in the cut grass.

GRASS STAGGERS: THE FACTS



What is magnesium?

Magnesium is a mineral which ruminants rely on for many body functions, including enzyme activation and energy metabolism.

How do ruminants store it?

70% of all magnesium is stored in the skeleton.

What happens if we don't supplement?

If the ruminant doesn't absorb the required level of magnesium, acute or chronic cases of hypomagnesaemia, also known as grass staggers, will be seen. When we turn animals out onto lush pasture, which is low in magnesium due to the way it grows, animals cannot mobilise their body stores quickly enough and blood levels fall rapidly. This results in cases of acute grass staggers. If not found and treated timeously, acute grass staggers has a high death rate. Chronic cases can also be seen, where blood levels of magnesium drop slowly over a longer period of time. Clinical cases are then brought on by a stressor, such as bad weather.

Which animals are at risk?

All ruminants are at risk of grass staggers, although acute cases are more often seen in older animals as the magnesium in the skeleton of older animals is not so readily available.

When and what should we supplement?

It is essential to supplement with bioavailable sources of magnesium all year round. Traditional sources of magnesium are very unpalatable and cannot be readily absorbed by the animal.

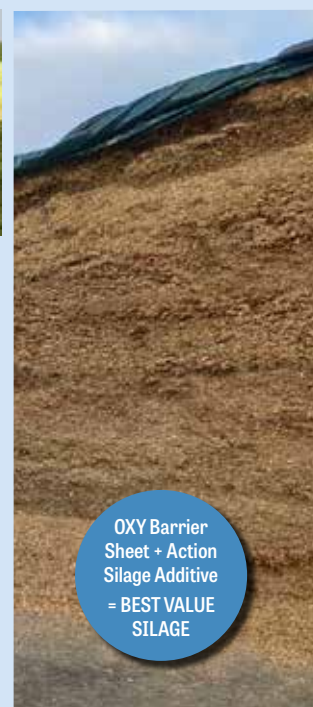

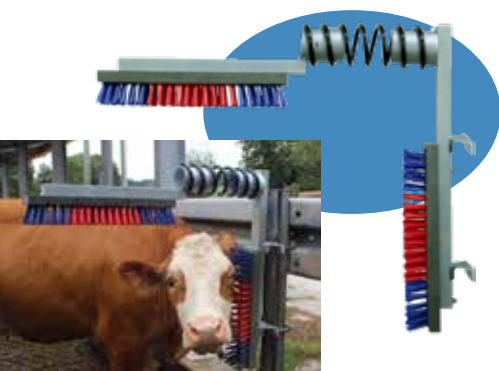
